

# Implementation

Projects can begin in the Chartiers Creek watershed whenever the ChCWA feels that they have all the necessary resources and information in place for a good restoration project at hand. A monitoring plan should be in place well before construction starts. Projects that require permitting (all streambank stabilization projects need General Permits from DEP) should be started months in advance of the actual construction dates. Streambank stabilization projects should be completed with the help of Pennsylvania Fish and Boat Commission habitat biologists through the Technical Assistance Program (TAP) by contacting Dave Keller at (814)-359-5158 or [dakeller@state.pa.us](mailto:dakeller@state.pa.us) or Dave Houser at (814)-359-5219 or [dhouser@state.pa.us](mailto:dhouser@state.pa.us) for lake projects. A database of projects should be kept that contains all relevant restoration information including monitoring, budgeting, volunteer logs for tracking match purposes, donated materials and equipment, or any other pertinent information.
